

Inspiration from Visit California

As we are heading towards spring, we want to give you all the inspiration for a great visit to California during sunny times. Below you will be introduced two great roadtrips through California and new openings, attractions and exciting places to visit in 2023.

Roadtrip - Santa Monica to San Luis Obispo

Soak up the sun as you head up the coast from Santa Monica to San Luis Obispo, making time for stops in places such as Malibu, Oxnard, and Ventura. This roadtrip will take you from Santa Monica to San Luis Obispo in 2 to 3 days and gives you the opportunity to make 12 stops along the way during the 211 miles.

The stops include visits to Ventura, Santa Barbara, Lompoc, Pismo Beach and Avila Beach.



Roadtrip - Golden Chain Highway

Travel back to the Gold Rush era on Highway 49, where charming mining towns are surrounded by panoramic vistas of the Sierra Nevada foothills. This roadtrip starts in Nevada City and ends in Columbia State Historic Park. The trip takes 2 to 3 days and has 7 stops during its 130 miles long journey.

The stops include visits to Nevada City, The South Fork American River, Marshall Gold Discovery State Park, Auburn, Plymouth, Columbia State Historic Park and Empire Mine State Historic Park.

Highline Adventures

Visitors can soar over the rolling hills of Santa Barbara County's wine country with the opening of a new zip line trail this spring. In addition to the mile of aerial cables stretching over the Santa Ynez Valley, the Buellton park will offer a ropes course and a low-key flower tour.



LEGOLAND California

This spring, the Carlsbad theme park will unveil the world's first LEGO City recreation of San Diego in its MINILAND USA. Coming later in the year, a new haunted house-themed attraction will feature a spooky storyline—and an upside-down spinning room.



SeaWorld San Diego

The West Coast's longest and fastest straddle coaster, Arctic Rescue, will launch in spring 2023 in San Diego. Riding aboard a snowmobile, guests will reach top speeds of up to 40 miles per hour while racing to save animals in distress.



Knott's Berry Farm

When the reimagined Fiesta Village opens over the summer in Buena Park, guests will enjoy brand-new eateries, elements inspired by Los Angeles' Olvera Street, and the return of a historic coaster. MonteZOOMa: The Forbidden Fortress, will feature a randomized launch sequence tied to a new treasure hunt storyline.
