Beautiful flower season in Mammoth Lakes

Spring and early summer are spectacular for wildflower viewing in the Eastern Sierra. As the season gets warmer, the peak bloom rises in elevation, but there is almost always a trail to see flowers. Our favorite wildflower hikes are in and around Mammoth Lakes and offer mountain views, alpine lakes, and plenty of wildflowers.


If you can't get enough of colors in the nature also check out these 7 fall color hikes near Mammoth Lakes.

Travelers can take these alternate east-west routes*:

1. EAST-WEST: Sonora Pass or Monitor Pass

2. NORTH: Carson Pass 8 or Luther Pass 8 via 50 / 4

3. SOUTH: Via Bakersfield 67 / 68



Update on Tioga Pass

Due to record snowfall this winter, Tioga Pass will be closed longer than usual this spring and summer. Road crews are working hard on clearing mountain roads, but the estimated opening date for Tioga/Hwy 120 West may not be until the beginning of July.



Is visiting Yosemite Mariposa County soon still a good idea?

- 1. Waterfalls. Yep, they're amazing this year. The flip side of the flood warnings are the unbelievable waterfalls. In addition to your favorite iconic falls, there are ephemeral as well as new waterfalls in Yosemite Valley.
- 2. NO reservations. There will be no reservations in <u>Yosemite National Park</u> through 2023. While this likely means more visitors, it's another reason to arrive early.
- 3. Your visit will help Mariposa County recover. The last few months have been brutal for this county of only 17,000 residents. Between record snowfall closing Yosemite National Park to rock slides to current flooding concerns but even if you only have 1 or 2 days of visit we've got great lodging options in Mariposa County where you can stay overnight and wake up early so you can make an early entry into the park.
