
Save the Date: Qatar Nordic Roadshow

How to get around in Qatar?

In Qatar you can travel by taxi, bus, metro, rental car or even a limousine. For those who want to travel by metro we have gathered some useful information. The metro system consists of 3 lines; the red, green and gold line. The 40 km **red line** connects Hamad International Airport to downtown Doha in under 20 minutes and up North to the University. The **green line** goes from Mall of Qatar in West to downtown Doha. And the **gold line** is the one you want to catch when you're visiting the Soug Wagif which is one of the 11 stations along the line.
