As California continues to be impacted by historic storms, the snow keeps falling in Mammoth Lakes. Since December 27, the Mountain has received 2,3 meters of new snow at Main Lodge, with more snow up top on The Summit. The environmental advocate, who was born in San Francisco, had his first exhibit at the fine arts museum in 1932. More than 100 of his pieces will be on display through July 23 along with works by other artists who share his passion for the environment.

## **Glacier Point Road Will Reopen**



After a full year of being closed to vehicle traffic for road rehabilitation and improvements, the popular Glacier Point Road will reopen with some traffic controls and delays in summer of 2023 as work continues. The advancement of the project means that visitors will be able to reach popular viewpoints such as Glacier Point, Washburn Point and McGurk Meadow as well as popular trailheads such as Taft Point, Sentinel Dome and Panorama Trail from Glacier Point down to the Valley Floor. Glacier Point Road's open date is determined based on when snow is cleared from the road beyond Badger Pass Ski Area. This usually happens around May or June each year.
