What's happening in Yosemite Mariposa County, Mammoth Lakes and California?

• Glacier Point in Yosemite will open. The portion of the road to Badger Pass will be open in 2023 when the ski area is open.

• <u>Mammoth Mountain</u> announced that it will remain open for "winter" (skiing and snowboarding) operations through at least July (no firm closing day has been set).

• Yesterday Mammoth Mountain surpassed its all-time record of 16.96 meters of total season snowfall.
